Director

The Yale Dramatic Association is looking to hire a Director for our Spring 2025 production of *Intimate Apparel* by Lynn Nottage. The Director will work closely with a team of professional and student designers and technical leads to foster a supportive learning environment. The show will run for five performances from April 2-5, 2025 in the University Theater which is a 640-seat venue on the campus of Yale University in New Haven, Connecticut.

The salary for the Director is \$6,000, housing in New Haven will be provided and there will be a travel stipend. Auditions and callbacks will take place between October 27th and November 9th, casting day will be November 10th, and initial, ad-hoc rehearsals will take place between November 11th and November 18th. Regular rehearsals will begin the week of January 13th, 2025. The Director is expected to be on-site full-time beginning the week of January 13th until the show closes on April 5th as well as throughout the audition process. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis until Sunday, October 6th, 2024. Those interested in applying should submit a current directing resume as well as a 1-2 page proposal addressing your interest in directing *Intimate Apparel*, a bit of information about yourself/your background, why you're interested in working with students, any specific artistic visions you've crafted for the show, and any other information you'd like to include.

The Yale University Dramatic Association (the Dramat) is an undergraduate organization at Yale College that operates as a student-run, non-profit production company. The organization produces six shows each academic year and is maintained by its Executive Board, made up of eleven students who collectively serve as the Dramat's artistic and managing directors.
